Instructions for presenters

Venue

The conference takes place at the **University of Copenhagen, South Campus, Building 23**. The address is Emil Holms Kanal 4, 2300 Copenhagen S. When you arrive on campus, follow the conference signs to the registration area, located on the ground floor of building 23. For the most convenient routes between the metro and the conference venue, please see the maps at the bottom of this newsletter:

- Route 1: Islands Brygge metro station to conference venue (10 min. walk).
- Route 2: Amagerbro metro station to conference venue (15 min. walk). If you arrive straight from the airport, Amagerbro metro station is part of the airport metro line.

Registration

Registration opens Wednesday 19 August at 11:00. If you arrive after the registration desk has closed, you can register by contacting a member of the organising committee. Registration will also be open on Thursday and Friday mornings.

Lunch on arrival Wednesday

The conference fee covers lunch and coffee breaks on all days of the conference. If you'd like to have lunch on Wednesday, make sure to arrive around 12, noon. Lunch is served from 12:00 till 12:45.

Welcome reception Wednesday evening

We invite all conference delegates to join us for a reception with refreshments (including non-alcoholic options) and finger food provided by *Jespers Torvekøkken* from 18:00 till 20:00 on Wednesday. We hope that you'll take this opportunity to connect with fellow delegates in an informal setting.

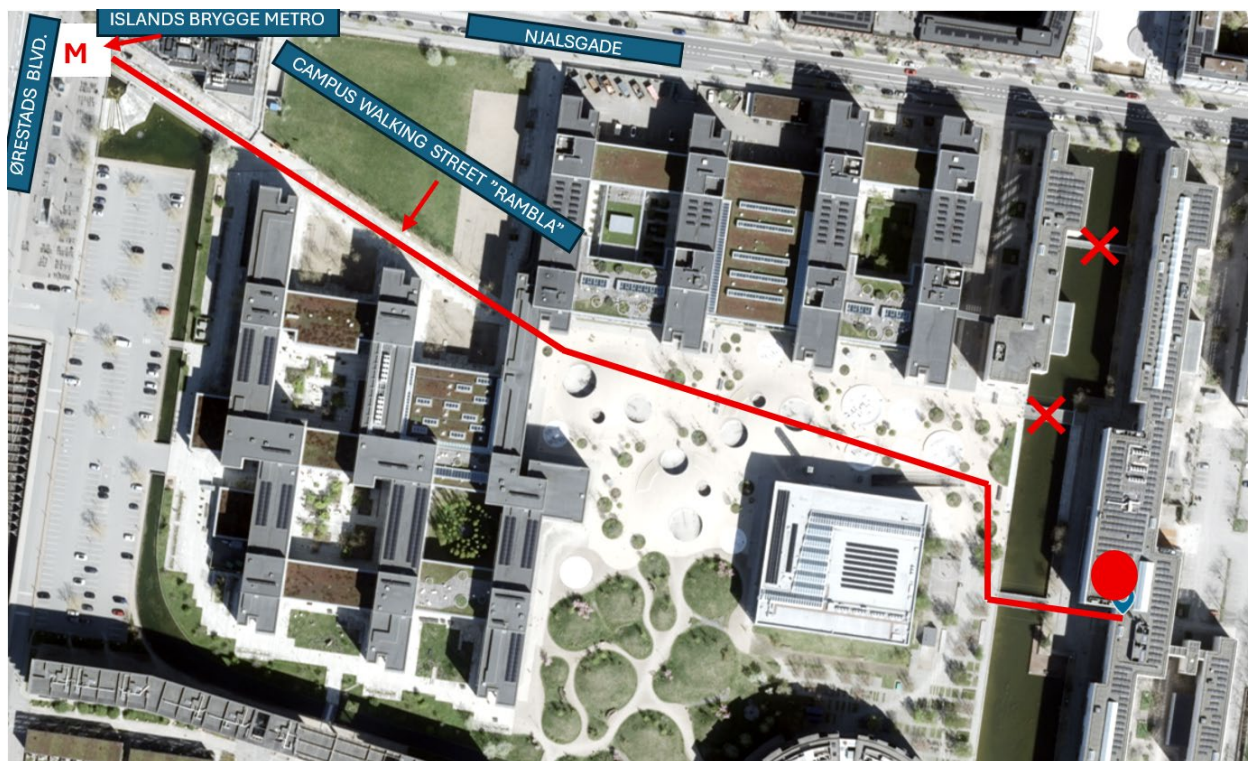
